Sub:- Postpone of the inspection of the Institution for issue of Renewal NOC for the academic Session 2020-2021 due to Covid-19

Sir

In inviting a reference to your letter No. 687 dated 04.06.2020on the subject cited above I am directed to say that after careful consideration of the proposal, the Govt. have taken the following decision to postpone the inspection of the Institution for renewal of NOC for the academic session 2020-2021 due to Covid- 19 situation.

- Renewal of NOC in all courses may be considered on the strength of
  affidavit with the condition that if during subsequent inspection, after
  normalcy of COVID I9 is restored, the NOC so issued will be revoked
  in case of any deficiencies of minimum requirement as per norms
  (The format of required affidavit is enclosed).
- The applications for issue of new NOC/ enhancement of seats/ revalidation of NOCs, where inspection is required, the same may be postponed for the time being taking into account the COVID 19 situation.
- In cases where inspection has already been conducted and there is scope to consider the case as per norms, the same may be considered after compliance of deficiencies.
- In cases, where order has been passed by Hon'ble Court, the same may be complied with.

In view of the above you are requested to take necessary steps as per the above decisions of the Govt..
