Sub: Guidelines for courses in Allied Medical Sciences in the State.

Taking into consideration the present requirement for the purpose, Government have been pleased to add and modify some clauses of the guidelines issued vide H & F W Department Resolution No.20127/H., dt.02.08.2018 for Degree/Certificate Course in Allied Medical Sciences in the State as mentioned below.

1. The following Post Graduation Courses of Allied Medical Science is included to the Sl. No. 18, 19, 20 of the different courses mentioned in the guidelines.

18. MSc. in Medical Laboratory Technology

: 2 Year Course

19. MSc. in Applied & Clinical Microbiology

: 2 Year Course

20. Certified Cath Lab Technician

· 2 Year Course

(For all the above 3 courses, the State Council for Allied Medical Science shall approve the above courses, if any institution intends to impart.)

- 2. The para (iii) of the Clause 33 of the guideline may be substituted as:
 - (iii) Affiliated or Own Hospital:- The institutions intending to impart allied medical science courses must have at least 100 bedded own hospital or tagged to another 100 bedded private hospital and where such hospital is not available, more than one (maximum 5) hospital may be tagged so as to have combined bed strength of 100 beds. The tagged hospitals shall not be more than 30 km from the academic institution. The Hospital must have an OPD attendance of 100 or more per day and at least 10 surgeries per day.

N.B: For Opthalmic courses, the OPD attendance must be at least 200 or more per day and must be conducting at least 20 opthalmic surgeries per day.

- 3. The following requirements is included in sub-para (h) & (i) of para (i) of the Clause 33 of the guideline.
 - (h) No Objection / Permission from Local Bodies (Development Authority/ Municipality / Corporation / Panchayat etc.) for the starting

educational institution.

(i) Fire Safety provision as per rules in force (Attach appropriate certificate from fire safety department)

Rest of the guidelines for courses in Allied Medical Sciences in the State issued vide H & F W Department Resolution No.20127/H., dt.02.08.2018 remained unchanged.

This will be applicable from the date of publication of this Resolution.
