
Sub: *Relieve of In-Service Medical Officers of OMHS Cadre from their duties for prosecuting PG studies during academic session 2019-20.*

Sir,

In enclosing herewith a copy of the letter No. 4149, dated-18.03.2019 of DMET, Odisha on the above subject, I am directed to say that as reported, the P.G. counseling for admission both under All India Quota and State Quota for the academic year of 2019-20 has already been started and continuing. As per the schedule, last date for joining in the college (for 1st round counseling) is 3rd April for All India Quota and 12th April for State Quota seats. Accordingly, the doctors working under OMHS Cadre on regular service are to be relieved from their duties so as to enable them to join the course in time.

It is, therefore, requested to relieve the regular doctors of OMHS Cadre working under your administrative control on production of Allotment / Admission letter issued by the Counseling Authority, 2019-20 subject to condition that the doctors remained absent unauthorisedly shall not be relieved without approval of the Government. Further, the adhoc and contractual doctors shall have to resign from service for the purpose.
