

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ANSWERING QUESTIONS (D.M / M.Ch)

1. The question booklet contains two papers containing 90 questions each.
2. Duration of examination is 3.00 hours.
3. Each question is a multiple choice type and has four suggested answers (A,B,C & D) out of which only one is correct.
4. A separate answer sheet of OMR type will be supplied separately to each candidate.
5. Candidates have to fill in the roll numbers and the speciality applied i.e DM or M.Ch. as per instruction on the answer sheet.
6. Candidates should use blue or black ball pen for filling in the circles. Putting any mark on places other than circles in the answer sheet will be liable for rejection.
7. Against each question number five blank circles are there (A,B,C,D & E). The candidates have to fill in the circle as per his correct answer (i.e A or B or C or D).
8. If the candidate does not know the answer then he has to fill in the E circle and will be awarded Zero mark.
9. For incorrect response, more than one response or no response he will be awarded minus 1 mark.
10. For cutting, erasing, overwriting or marking with pencil will be awarded zero mark.
11. At the end of examination the candidates have to return both the question booklet and answer sheet to the invigilator.
12. Any correction made to the questions and declared in examination hall shall be final and binding.
