In legal complications convener shall take necessary steps in filing counters on behalf of the Chairman, Selection Committee and/or Govt. of Odisha, Health & FW department. The decision of selection committee with regard to selection and admission shall be final & binding. The convener shall open an account in the Nationalized Bank for the purpose of counseling and admission. The balance fund of sale proceeds shall be returned to the DMET Odisha to be deposited in the "Entrance Examination Fees, DMET, Odisha" Account. Expenditure shall be made as per the approved budget and strictly as per the guidelines of expenditure communicated by DMET, Odisha.

3. Applications are invited in the prescribed form for admission into two years M. Phil in Psychiatric social work Course for the session 2016 -2017 to be commenced in Mental Health Institute, SCB Medical College, Cuttack. 5. ELIGIBILITY:

- 5.1 M.A. / M.Sc. degree in Sociology/Social work or MSW from a recognized University with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate, preferably with special paper in psychiatric social work or medical social work or social preventive medicine. For ST/SC category, minimum of 50% marks in aggregate is essential.
- 5.2 The candidate has to be a permanent resident of Odisha.

6. APPLICATION FEES:

Fee of Rs. 1500/- (One thousand five hundred only) in shape of Bank Draft of State Bank of India, drawn in favor of "**Convener, Selection Committee, MHI, Cuttack**" Payable at Cuttack, is to be enclosed in original along with the application. The Bank Draft is not refundable under any circumstances.

7. DOCUMENTS TO BE ENCLOSED WITH THE APPLICATION FORM:

- a) Self-attested copy of resident/ nativity certificate from the competent authority issued not before than two years.
- b) Self-attested copy of H.S.C. certificate.
- c) Self-attested copies of certificates & mark sheets of M.A/ M.S.W
- d) Self-attested copy of conduct certificate from the institution last attended.
- e) Self-attested copy of certificate from competent authority in support of reservation category claimed.
- f) Two recent passport size photographs (one to be affixed in the application form and another in the Admit Card).
- g) One self-addressed envelope (25x 12 cms) with Rs.40/- postage stamp affixed.
- h) Copy of the intimation letter to the employer if applicable (vide Clause 16.6)

8. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

The selection will be made strictly on merit determined by the marks obtained in written examination, interview and practical. Written test will be of 90 marks consisting of 90 MCQ type Questions of M.A/ M.S.W. (Social work/Sociology) standard and of 60 minutes duration. Cutting, over writing or erasing in the answer sheet will be awarded 0(zero) mark. Interview & practical will be of 10 marks. Applicants from Unreserved category will be called to appear in the interview and practical in the ratio of 1:3 and for reserved category the ratio will be 1:4.

Note :- In case of tie the candidate securing more marks in the qualifying examination i.e. M.A. in Social work/Sociology or M.S.W will be ranked senior, and if still tie exist the candidate older in age will be ranked senior to younger.

12. RAGGING -

14. DISCONTINUATION OF STUDIES:-

14.1. In case a trainee discontinues the course he/she will have to refund the stipend/salary if any received and a monetary penalty of Rs 50,000/- (Fifty thousand only) will be charged.

14.2. Disqualification from Continuing the Course

The trainee will be declared disqualified from continuing the course under the following circumstances:

- 14.2.1 Any form of misconduct with any patient / faculty member / staff (if it is confirmed by the concerned disciplinary committee approved by the Director)
- 14.2.2. If disqualification is suggested by a disciplinary committee.
- 14.2.3. If the trainee does not appear in the examination for 3 consecutive times.
- 14.2.4. Submission of false documents or concealing related information.
- 14.2.5. If the trainee does not follow the rules and regulations of the Institute.

- 14.2.6. Trainee once expelled from the Institute will be disqualified to appear in any examination in M.H.I.in future.
- 14.2.7. If a trainee is absent from the class/clinics without prior written information for more than one month, his/her name will be struck off from the rolls.

15. LEAVE MATTERS:-

- 15.1. Casual leave, maximum of 15 days per academic year, shall be permitted during the course period.
- 15.2. For any kinds of leave the decision of the institutional head shall be final.

16. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS :-

- 16.1 Incomplete applications will be rejected. Applications received after the closing date will not be considered.
- 16.2 No communication will be provided against the rejected applications.
- 16.3 Candidates are advised to send their applications by registered/speed post only. Institute takes no responsibility for any delay in the receipt or loss of application in transit. Application submitted by any other means shall be rejected.
- 16.4 All declaration made in the application must be supported with documentary proof.
- 16.5 Candidates must bring all certificates in original on the day of interview for verification failing which they will not be allowed to appear the interview and practical exam.
- 16.6 Employees of the State or Central Government or of any public sector undertaking should apply directly to the Convener with intimation to their employer. Copy of such intimation letter is to be attached along with the application form.
- 16.7 Candidates called for entrance examination have to make their own arrangements for stay. No TA/DA is admissible for this purpose.
- 16.8 The decision of Selection Committee shall be final in the matters of the selection of candidates.
- 16.9 Candidates are strictly prohibited from undergoing any other part-time or correspondence course during the period of training.
- 16.10 Selected candidates shall have to submit the Migration Certificate and Transfer Certificate from the Board/University from which they have passed the last qualifying examination at the time of admission.

Government after careful consideration have been pleased to decide to bring M.H.I. under the administrative control of Director, Medical Education And Training, Odisha (No. DC & MA (MH)-16/2012/34082/H. Dated 28.12.2012).

M.H.I., S.C.B. M.C.H, Cuttack has been upgraded to Centre of Excellence in Mental Health during 2010 under the National Mental Health Programme - Man power Development Scheme. Three new departments like Department of Psychiatric Social Work, Clinical Psychology, and Psychiatric Nursing have been opened in addition to the existing department of Psychiatry in M.H.I. to create man-power in Mental Health. M.H.I. S.C.B. M.C.H, Cuttack, is the premier institute for the care of mentally ill over last five decades.

AIM & OBJECTIVES OF M. PHIL IN PSYCHIATRIC SOCIAL WORK COURSE

In the comprehensive system of human development in all areas of disabilities, one of the most vital areas, the domain Psychiatric Social Work. Between acute centers of Psychiatric intervention and the rehabilitation of chronic mentally ill in the society in community based rehabilitation module, psychiatric social worker has been modeled to a bridge. To reach the unreached large number of mentally ill population and to negate the influence of superstition, stigma around psychiatric illness, to bring them to the domain of modern holistic psychiatric care under bio-psycho-social –spiritual model, psychiatric social worker has the pivotal role.

AIM:

The aim of the course is to prepare the trainee to function as a qualified professional in Psychiatric social work in the area of mental and physical health by offering Diagnostic, Therapeutic, Rehabilitative services and research orientation and promoting the wellbeing and quality of life of individual and to uplift the social perception of the mentally ill as well as the attitude of the society to affected individuals.

OBJECTIVES:

The course is developed as a rigorous two years programme with extensive theoretical inputs and widespread clinical experience to acquire the necessary skill in the area of psychiatric social work. On completion of the course, the trainee is expected to perform the following functions.

- Diagnose Mental Health Problems.
- Conceptualize specific adult and child mental health problems within a psychosocial frame work, giving due consideration to psychosocial/cultural/ moral-spiritual/contextual factors and carryout relevant treatment/ management/ advocacy/ rehabilitation in family, social and occupational setting.
- Apply psychosocial principles and techniques in rehabilitating persons with mental health problems and social disabilities.
- Work with the psychosocial dimensions of physical diseases formulate and undertake focused/targeted psychosocial intervention and research.
- Work with community to promote health/quality of life and psychological wellbeing.
- Work with institutions and communities to promote human right dimensions and ethical psychosocial practices.
- Undertake research in the areas of psychiatric social work such as mental health/illness, physical health/diseases and relevant societal issues i.e. misconception, stigma, discrimination, and quality of life etc.
