Madam/Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, you are hereby authorised to do the selection of JR required for your institution against the sanctioned posts, observing the stipulations in the Guideline issued by H & FW Deptt, Govt. of Odisha, i.e., Govt. notification No. 18582 dt. 13/08/2020.

The appointment of JR on contractual basis will be conducted through Walk in Interview mode.


1. As per vacancy arising against the sanctioned post, the recruitment will be conducted on 20th of every month (next working day in case of holiday), strictly adhering to norms laid down in Govt. notification No: 18582 dt 13/08/2020. "Guidelines for engagement of Junior Residents (JR)/ Senior Resident (SR)/Tutors in Govt. Medical/Dental Colleges of the State of Odisha"
2. The Committee comprising of Dean & Principal of Medical College, Superintendent of Hospital & one Senior Faculty of Medical College will be the selecting authority. The Dean and Principal of Medical College will be the engaging authority.
3. The selection will be strictly on the basis of merit list prepared on the basis of career marks for different examination as under.

- a. HSC/Matriculation 20% of the total percentage of marks secured
 - b. Intermediate Science 20% of the total percentage of marks secured
 - c. MBBS 60% of the total percentage of marks secured
 - d. One mark will be deducted from the total career marks for each extra attempt taken to pass the examination.
 - e. In the case of Foreign Medical Graduates (FMG), the marks secured in the subjects as per NMC or MCI conducted by NBE shall be taken for the calculation of merit as above. Where the candidate does not submit such a marksheet, their mark shall be taken as 50%.
 - f. The Dean and Principal is authorised to sign appointment letters for selected candidates and issue them.
 - g. The Dean and Principal of Medical College will send the selection list and engagement order along with proceedings to DMET (O) for post facto approval as per Govt. notification No. 18582 dated August 13, 2020.
 - h. The Dean and Principal of Medical College will intimate DMET(O) of the vacancies after the recruitment process on the 20th of every month (next working day in case of holiday), so that DMET(O) will conduct a walk-in interview on the 27th of every month (next working day in case of holiday) for further vacancies (if any).
4. The remuneration and incentives, as may be notified by Govt. from time to time for the above post, shall be applicable.

The Govt.in H & FW Deptt. notification No. 18582 dated August 13, 2020 is enclosed herewith for reference.


